- 1. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as a true record.
- 2. Matters arising: None not on the Agenda.
- 3. Update from OSL Director:
 - UR presented an update on the budget and the actual spending to the end of March 2022. All spending is in line with projections. The audited accounts for 2020-21 are currently being prepared and will be returned to the CRO by the due date in May.

2. Staff update:

- . Some OSL staff are now working exclusively on campus, though others (approx. 5-6) have availed of the option to WFH for 1-2 days as provided for in the agreed Work-Life balance policy. It is organised so that no student-facing services are impacted.
- The student employment programme with student staff employed on the Helpdesk staff, U crew, Clubs and Socs staff and occasional events staff was very successful this year. Recruitment is underway for next year's staff complement.
- ii. The peer mentor pilot programme has been successful to date. A survey of the mentors and some mentees reinforced the positive impact that it has had.
- iii. The Clubs and Socs Awards returned to an in-person event in early April and was well attended.
